Restoration Bible College offers nonacademic programs leading to diplomas and degree with theology and biblical designations. Each course requires seven hours of classroom instruction in addition to required assigned readings.

*Courses completed through Restoration Bible College may not be applied toward associate, bachelor, master, or Ph.D. degrees in arts or sciences or toward academic or CEU credits.* The following degrees are awarded upon successful completion of the required course hours and curriculum requirements.

## DIPLOMA OF THEOLOGY – 70 Units

The successful completion of 10 RBC courses with a grade of “C” or better per course.

## ASSOCIATE OF THEOLOGY – 140 Units

The successful completion of 20 RBC courses with a grade of “C” or better per course.

## BACHELOR OF THEOLOGY – 280 Units

The successful completion of 40 RBC courses with a grade of “C” or better per course.

Students may also enroll in the bachelor degree program if they meet the following criteria:

- successful completion of an Associate in Theology degree program from another institution deemed reputable by the board of Restoration Bible College
- official transcript and course description of all classes taken
- all other enrollment criteria for Restoration Bible College

## AUDIT/NON-CREDIT SEEKING

Students may enroll in Restoration Bible College as audit/non-credit seeking students. All audit/non-credit seeking students are required to register and pay for each course they attend. Audit/non-credit seeking students are not required to submit course work and will not receive a grade for any course taken. **Students admitted under this program are not eligible for diplomas or degrees with theology and biblical designations.**
